

What will energy storage look like in 2023?

Will energy storage costs remain high in 2023?

Costs are expected to remain high in 2023 before dropping in 2024. The energy storage system market doubles, despite higher costs. The global energy storage market will continue to grow despite higher energy storage costs, adding roughly 28GW/69GWh of energy storage by the end of 2023.

How do energy storage technologies affect the development of energy systems?
