Tea leaves expire because of storage conditions, getting into contact with air and being exposed to mold, heat or water. Even though many packaged teas have an expiration date printed on the packaging, properly stored tea will be likely safe to use long after that date.

Can tea be stored at room temperature?

Yes, tea can be stored at room temperature provided it's kept in an airtight container. Do loose tea leaves expire? Technically, tea does not expire, however, if not kept properly or stored for very long the taste will deteriorate. Tea is easily affected by air, humidity, temperature, sunlight and odors.

How to store loose tea?

Exposure to air may adulterate the tea with impurities such as dust, increase moisture content and cause the tea to develop foul/unpleasant flavor. Therefore, it is imperative to store loose tea in airtight containers or re-sealable zipper pouches. 3. Avoid storing tea in warm places

How to store tea if you don't have an airtight container?

If you don't have airtight or stainless steel containers, use paper bags as a backup. But, keep the bag tight, away from the air. Store at room temperature. This is very important to preserve all the volatile features of your loose tea leaves. Temperature fluctuation can damage the tea.
