How long can thawed, previously frozen breast milk stay in the fridge?

Thawed, previously frozen breast milk can stay in the refrigerator for 24 hours before you have to throw it out. Freshly pumped breast milk can be stored in the back of the refrigerator (39°F or 4°C) for up to four days.

How long should breast milk stay in a bottle?

Any remaining breast milk left in a bottle after your baby is finished with a feeding should be used within two hours, or, if quickly refrigerated, used for the next feeding. To prevent your breast milk from going to waste, store it in small batches; 2 to 4 ounces (59.1 to 118.2 milliliters) is recommended.
