What temperature should freezer ice cubes be?

A standard freezer temperature is 0°F degrees or -18°C degrees. You should use caution though, since the colder the freezer temperature, the greater the risk of freezer burn on items being frozen. What is the best temperature to freeze ice?

The best freezer temperature to freeze ice is 0 degrees Fahrenheit or -18 degrees Celsius. This is also the default temperature for most freezers. Lower temperatures cause food items to become freezer burnt faster.
