

# Is there a big demand for phase change energy storage materials

Are phase change materials suitable for thermal energy storage?

Phase change materials (PCMs) having a large latent heat during solid-liquid phase transition are promising for thermal energy storage applications. However, the relatively low thermal conductivity of the majority of promising PCMs ( $<10 \text{ W/(m} \cdot \text{K)}$ ) limits the power density and overall storage efficiency.

How to apply phase change energy storage in New Energy?

Application of phase change energy storage in new energy: The phase change materials with appropriate phase change temperature should be selected according to the practical application. The heat storage capacity and heat transfer rate of phase change materials should be improved while the volume of phase change materials is controlled.

Latent energy storage is dependent on the storage medium's phase transition. Acetate of metal or nonmetal, melting point  $150\text{--}500^\circ\text{C}$ , is used as a storage medium.

Materials to be used for phase change thermal energy storage must have a large latent heat and high thermal conductivity [54], [55]. They should have a melting temperature lying in the practical range of operation, melt congruently with minimum subcooling and be chemically stable, low in cost, nontoxic and non-corrosive [56], [57], [58] .

To store thermal energy, sensible and latent heat storage materials are widely used. Latent heat thermal energy storage (TES) systems using phase change materials (PCM) are useful because of their ability to charge and discharge a large amount of heat from a small mass at constant temperature during a phase transformation.
