What happened at the 'Eni' warehouse in Florence?

Clouds of smoke rise could be seen following an explosion at the 'Eni' warehouse in Calenzano, Florence, and was spotted from nearby towns. Nine people have also been injured, according to authorities.

What happened at an ENI fuel depot?

It happened at an ENI fuel depot north of Florence. A dark plume of smoke was seen rising into the air. Witnesses who were nearby reported a large bang and tremors. Flames were quickly contained, preventing the fire from spreading to storage tanks from a loading dock area where the explosion occurred.

What happened at the Eni plant in Calenzano?

Explosion this morning at the Eni plant in Calenzano, in the province of Florence. The column of smoke is also visible from neighboring municipalities, while firefighters, law enforcement and regional health emergency personnel rushed to the scene. The terrible explosion was felt even in centers very distant from the place where it occurred.

What happened at Calenzano fuel depot?

Italian energy group Eni, which owns the site, said the fire broke out on Monday morning at a fuel depot in Calenzano. "The fire brigade is working to put out the flames, which are confined to the loading shelter area and do not affect the tanks in any way," the firm added. "The impacts and causes are being immediately verified."
